**Qualification:**

All members of the Board must be alumni of the Neag School of Education.

**Board Terms/Participation:**

Each member of the Neag School of Education Alumni Board serves a three-year term and is eligible for reappointment for one additional term. After a year rotation off the Board, a member may be appointed for a third term. Board meetings will be held four times a year, and additional meetings will be scheduled as needed. All meetings will have a virtual option.

- Participating in Alumni Board committee(s) efforts
- Representing the Neag School of Education to stakeholders as ambassadors for the organization

## Alumni Board Committees

### Recruitment, Scholarship and Philanthropy

This group is responsible for board recruitment, selecting student scholarship recipients, championing UConn Gives participation, and promoting giving to the Neag School and the Board's scholarship fund.

### Alumni Awards and Traditions
